Your letter to Harry U. Brown, dated October 5, 1990, requested a copy of a study which identified certain atolls and islands likely to have received fallout from U.S. nuclear tests at Enewetak and Bikini.

The Nevada Operations Office of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) did not undertake or direct such a study. Our Headquarters, Office of Environment, Safety and Health (EH), is in touch with those individuals, some of whom have since retired from DOE, who would be able to address your question.
