## WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE ON FALLOUT PROTECTION

INTRODUCTORY CLASSICAL BY GOVERNOR ROCKET GLIS

At their annual Conference is Fuerto Rico last August the assembled State Governors declared their personal and official responsibility, as Governors, for the protection of their people against the hazard of fallout in the event of a nuclear war. In keeping with this sense of responsibility, they unanimously adopted both the report of their Special (ommittee on Chall Aufors and a four point resolution calling for

- First Vigorous state initiative in a campaign of education about the raillest mazard and production against it.
- Second- Immediate steps by a la levels of government state and local as well as Federal, to assist their citizens to survive radioactive falls. and the related consequences of a walk no attack upon our a rimerous
- Third State initiative to surve, the adequaty of fallout protection is state owned or agentation facilities and the steps which sho like taken to achieve such projection.
- Fourth- State initiative in developing a protected seat of state government to assure government leadership and Junctioning both desire as after a nuclear atta k.

This extraordinary resolution showed plainly that the Governors not only recognized the compalling urgenes of the problem, but were ready to take initiative in its solution. In the five months since the Governors alted potentially rewarding and constructive steps have been taken by a sumper of Governors is it as a bone. states. More will be done in the months ahead.
