WE SOUGHT ADVICE FROM MARSHALLESE GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS,
LEGAL COUNSELS REPRESENTING THE MARSHALLESE PEOPLE, EDUCATORS,
AND COMMUNITY WORKERS AT MAJURO.
