Dear Mr. Bradbury:

The President has requested the Atomic Energy Commission to convey his commendation to the scientific personnel responsible for the success of the 1945 atomic weapon test program at Eniwetok Atoll.

The success of the tests was due to the combined effort of many people and groups, some of whom were actively identified with the Proving Ground Group at Eniwetok, while others remained at Los Alamos in their normal assignments. The advances made in atomic weapons since the war which were demonstrated at Eniwetok are due to the combined efforts of the members of the Laboratory under your able direction.
